
ShelterLuv Intake Procedure


 Search for the person who is bringing in the cat. (I suggest only their first name or last name to lessen the chance for typos) Be sure that the Person bubble is selected.



If the person is not there, create a person by clicking either
Add New+




or create a new person



- Create a Person
 - Fill in all required fields with the red asterisk * and any additional information you may have
 - Click Save

Adding the Animal

- Once on the person's profile, click on the **Animals** tab
- Click **Add Animal** dropdown and select the appropriate intake subtype for this animal, it will usually be **Found a Stray** or **Owner Surrender**




o If **Owner Surrender**, you will be asked to select the animal or enter a new animal. If the cat they are surrendering was adopted from us, it will already be in ShelterLuv and you will see it on their Animals tab page. If the cat is there, click the green **Select** next to the animal and then click **Owner Surrender**. If the animal was not adopted from us and is not in ShelterLuv, click the <u>here</u> link in the blue highlighted area that appears just below **Add Animal**.

- Age Group
 - Unless you know the cat/kitten age enter general Adult (1-10 years) or Teenager (6 months-1 year) or Kitten (8 weeks-6 months) or Kitten Unweaned (0-8 weeks) based on what you can tell
- Adoption Fee Group
 - Select appropriate Adult Cat (\$75.00) or Kitten (\$75.00)

 - Please take a photo of the cat/kitten and upload it here. Click the large plus icon, click Browse, select photo, crop if necessary or desired, click Add

 - unk or unknown

- Intake Date

 - Select Cat from the dropdown menu
- Sex
 - What the owner tells you unless they don't know, then **unknown**
- Altered Before Arrival
 - What the owner tells you unless they don't know, then **unknown**
- Primary Breed
 - What the owner tells you unless they don't know, then enter if you can tell, typically they will be **Domestic Short/Medium/Long hair**
- o Color
 - There is a Main Color and Secondary Color option, you do not need to do both
- Pattern
 - If they have a pattern and you can tell it, usually **Tabby** or **Tortie** or **Calico** or **Tuxedo**

- o Age Group
 - Unless you know the cat/kitten age enter general Adult (1-10 years) or Teenager (6 months-1 year) or Kitten (8 weeks-6 months) or Kitten Unweaned (0-8 weeks) based on what you can tell
- Adoption Fee Group
 - Select appropriate Adult Cat (\$75.00) or Kitten (\$75.00)
